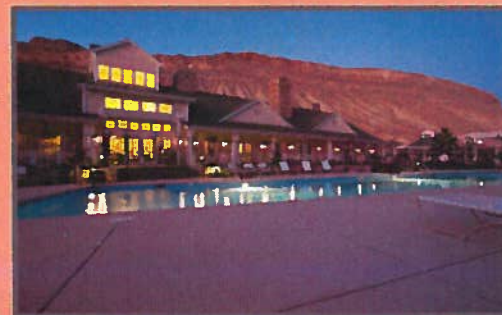
Day one Saturday – June 22, 2019 Arrive in Denver, One night—Embassy Suites

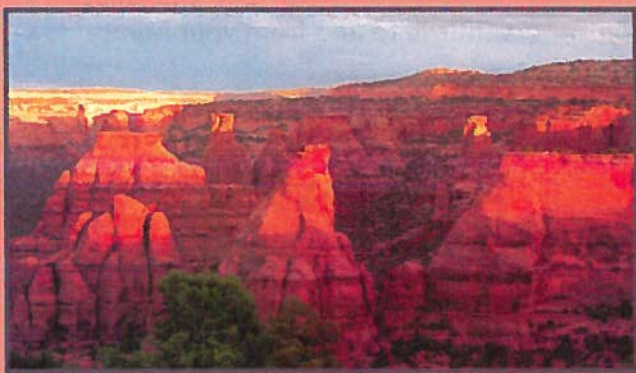

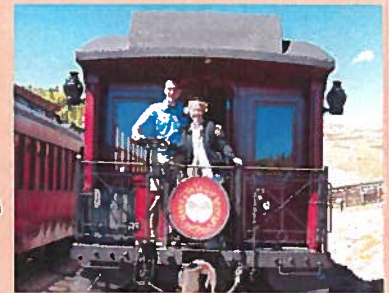

Day Six Thursday June 27, 2019 – Alamosa, - Holiday Inn Express

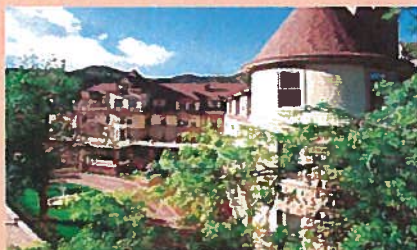
