3:00 pm Encounter the **Wonder of Christmas Time** at the **Ark.** Spend the afternoon touring the **Ark Encounter.** Warm up inside and explore the Ark Encounter! Scores of exhibits about the Flood, Noah, and the animals are designed to answer your questions about the biblical account of Noah's Ark. Then enjoy a **Holiday Buffet at Emzara's.**



As the night falls upon the Ark, guests will encounter the wonder with a world-class laser projections show that will depict animals walking up the Ark ramp, as the floodwaters rising, a cutaway of the Ark's three decks allows guests to peer inside, and the Christmas message, in a striking fashion, will light up the side of our massive Ark as a screen. Guests will be able to observe the outside of the 510-foot-long Ark up close, shop inside its large gift store offering extensive fair trade items (and shop at other artisan stores in the West Village), and stroll through Ararat Ridge Zoo.

Included is a visit to **Doscher's Candy Co.,** founded in 1871 by Claus Doscher, a German immigrant who arrived in Cincinnati when he was just 19. He created the first Dosher's hand-crafted candy cane using real peppermint oil, cooking the candy in small batches in copper kettles, and working with the best tools known to man – his hands to roll, knead, stripe and hook the canes. Along with candy canes, he developed a recipe for French Chew, a chewy fruit nougat candy, which has also stood the test of time. **Everyone gets some samples.**

Plus, a visit to the **Krohn Conservatory**, a Cincinnati tradition at Christmas when visitors come from all over to see it. There are countless Pink poinsettias featured in the Christmas Show and the Poinsettia Tree is a sight to behold. Little trains work their way across bridges, through flowers, around the little



cottages... touches like this make the display unique, The Cottage is surrounded by a forest of cyclamen. A tiny river flows down the hill in the background. The nativity offers guests the reason for the season.

layout in the world, with more than 2 miles of track with 90 G-scale trains. Visitors are sure to transcend themselves to yesteryear upon entering EnterTRAINment throughout a 19th century streetscape and train depot; featuring 17-ft mountains and 11-ft waterfalls. There's also a railroad museum, and hobby shop. Make sure you visit the Christmas displays!

Shopping time and coupon books at the upscale Outlet Mall – **Cincinnati Premium Outlets.** Fill your shopping bags with holiday gifts at the 400,000 square foot outdoor shopping center with more than one hundred and twenty stores. Shops such as Saks Fifth Avenue Off 5th, Chico's, Maidenform, Ralph Lauren, Tommy Hilfinger, Jones of New York Aeropostale, 20 different stores, Direct Tool & Outlet Yankee Candle just to name a few!
