**Monday:** JB Tours will begin by traveling to ASHEVILLE, North Carolina and checking into the HAMPTON INN by HILTON for the evening.

Originally constructed as a country home by, 25 year old, George Vanderbilt, grandson of entrepreneur and industrialist Cornelius Vanderbilt, "The House" is an expansive 250 room French chateau in gothic design. Construction took six years to complete from 1889 to 1895, involving a workforce of 1000 people.

The footprint of the house covers the expanse of four football fields. A forerunner for the times, the development included electricity, central heating, running water and functional bathrooms.

**Wednesday:** After breakfast it's to the GREAT SMOKY MOUNTAIN RAILROAD. This scenic rail excursion takes you through the beautiful countryside. Next you board the bus and travel to Pigeon Forge and check into the BLACK FOX LODGE to enjoy two nights' accommodations
