Jenny Wiley State Park Jenny Wiley State Resort Park was founded as Dewey Lake State Park on January 1, 1954, with Dewey Lake near Prestonsburg, Kentucky as its centerpiece. It was renamed in the early 1950s for Virginia "Jenny" Wiley, a pioneer woman who is remembered as a survivor of captivity by Native Americans. It became one of the resort parks in the state in 1962 with the opening of the May Lodge.

Musical Entertainment by "Front Porch Pickin" Founded by three moms, Front Porch Pickin has grown from a small dream to a massive event filled with hundreds of artisans, pickers, and designers sharing a smorgasbord of curated talent. Enjoy a relaxing and scenic Pontoon Boat Ride It is a great way to unwind and take in the stunning landscape.

Jenny Wiley Monologue (Shannon Daniels) This is a captivating theatrical performance that brings to life the rich history and folklore surrounding Jenny Wiley, a courageous woman who was captured by Native Americans in the 1700s and later escaped. The monologue offers a dramatic retelling of Jenny Wiley's harrowing journey, blending storytelling with emotional depth. Then on to Middlecreek National Battlefield (with soldier), Samuel May House – (Tour) , Catered dinner with dessert "Under the stars", East KY Science Center & Planetarium Tour Depart for the Hatfield & McCoy Tour. This tour takes visitors on a fascinating journey through the history of the infamous family feud between the Hatfield's of West Virginia and the McCoy's of Kentucky. The tour typically included visits to key sites related to the conflict, offering insights into the events that fueled the violent rivalry. Led by knowledgeable guides, the tour brings to life the dramatic and often tragic stories of the two families, providing unique opportunity to learn about the iconic chapter in Appalachian history while enjoying the picturesque landscape surrounding the park. We will also see Randall McCoy Well Site, Hog Trial Cabin , Paw Paw Tree Sight all three with an interpreters. Lunch will be at Wingos then on to the Hatfield/McCoy – Matewan Train Museum. Just for fun there will be a rousing game of "Family Feud" en route to lodging.

Next is a guided tour at Mayo Methodist Church and US 23 Country Music Highway Museum Tour. This tour celebrates the rich heritage of country music in the region. It showcases memorabilia and exhibits honoring the legendary artist who grew up along the US corridor, highlighting their contributions to the genre, this iconic chapter in Appalachian history while enjoying the picturesque landscape surrounding the park.
