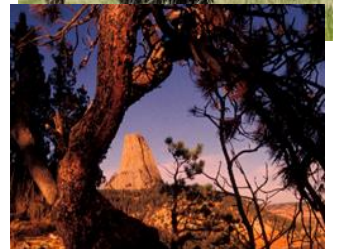
Day Three – June 2, 2026 - Keystone, South Dakota – K Bar S Lodge
