Day One we will travel to Albany New York and stop at Erie Canal Historic Park and then spend the night at our hotel.

Day Two we will travel to Boston and stop at Quincy Market/Faneuil Hall Marketplace. It is just a short walk to the North End of Boston Passing by Paul River's House. A stop is made to go inside for a visit of the Old North Church. Board the motor coach and transfer to the USS Constitution. Visit Old Ironsides, the oldest commissioned ship and museum. Enjoy a dinner. Relax at our hotel for the evening.

Day Three board the motor coach and depart for Boston Common/gardens. Here you begin a walk on the Freedom Trail including the Old Granary Burial Ground, Park St. Church, King's Chapel, and Boston House (we are not walking the entire Freedom Trail, just a small part). End the morning at the public gardens and take a ride on the historic Swan Boats. Continue by coach to the Harbor. Take in some of the music celebrations. In the evening we will return to the hotel.

Day four depart by coach for a full day in Boston. Board Classic Cruises for a harbor cruise highlighting the annual turnaround of the USS Constitution and 21 gun salute. After lunch tour of the Historic baseball park. Then last chance for a little more sightseeing (on own), of ongoing 4th of July celebrations. Return to the hotel for a rooftop barbecue, drinks and 4th of July fireworks. What a spectacular finish!

Day five end the 250 celebration in Albany to view the largest international flotilla of tall ships and naval vessels ever assembled as the sail up the Hudson to dock in Albany.

Day six- we will return home after 5 days of grandeur.
