SHOPPING:

The Hartville MarketPlace & Flea Market is a large indoor/outdoor market in Stark County, Ohio, featuring over 12 acres of vendors selling antiques, collectibles, clothing, home decor, and fresh produce, with the indoor shops open year-round on Mondays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, and the outdoor flea market operating seasonally on the same days. It originated as a livestock auction in 1939 and has grown into a major shopping destination with a wide variety of unique goods and a family-friendly atmosphere.

Indoor MarketPlace: A two-story, climate-controlled building with over 60 shops selling everything from clothing and jewelry to antiques and specialty foods.

****Farmer's Market:** Available seasonally (April-October) on all operating days, providing fresh produce, meats, and cheeses.
